

## Guidelines for final preparation

### *Slide 1. The topic*

– a topic is chosen in harmony with the theme of master's thesis (preferably, but not necessarily);

The topic is a burning issue in accordance with the topics of the Jean Monnet project (current problems of land use (e.g. organic farming), environmental issues (landfills, their reclamation or incineration of garbage or recycling, green economy, alternative energy sources, etc., the problem of complex processing of resources, optimization of forest cover, climate change and its impact on forests, tourism, the application of the principles which are listed in the European project Natura 2000, etc, landscape planning in cities, towns, landscaping, etc., forest governance – Finnish experience, Polish in the control system and the system of forest regeneration, harvesting, processing, etc.;

### *Slide 3. Message box*

5 sectors briefly describe

In the center (*issue*) – to put the topic of problem

*Problems* – to emphasize environmental, social, economic side of problems

*Solutions* – problem solving (event);

*Benefits* – the benefits of solving problems (environmental, social, economic);

*So What* – the specification of the problem what is the problem.

### *Slide 4. Research methodology*

Methodology is the theory (e.g., efficiency, sustainable development, sustainable forest management etc.), you can specify how you do the MS thesis.

Remember, methods are not equal methodology!!!)

*Slide 5-7* or more characteristics of the object, the description of the problem, to specify the references (possible on a separate slide)

*Slides 8-10* of the Solution (the proposed activities), to specify the references (possible on a separate slide)

Everywhere to make art – photos, tables, graphs

*Slides 11-13.* The European experience of solving such problems (pictures, tables, graphs). to specify the references (possible on a separate slide)
